Fee:

The fee is 80,00 EUR covering the scientific and cultural programme, lunches and coffee breaks, conference material and a dinner. The fee should be paid in advance via bank transfer. The account is announced in the registration form.

Travel options:

It is recommended to use Frankfurt/Main or Vienna as hub airports. Usually there are four flights a day from there to Innsbruck. Munich could also be an option; there are good train connection from Munich to Innsbruck (2,5 hrs).

For transport from Innsbruck airport to the city centre, please use bus line F (Sundays any 30 min) to “Anichstrasse/Rathausgalerie” (driving time 10 min). From there 5 min walking distance, via Maria-Theresien-Strasse (in northern direction), to the *Golden Roof* in the historic centre and from there to the left to the nearby Hotel Goldener Adler.
